Dear Student,

As noted in my email to all students, 1048 Trinity College students who meet the federal government's eligibility criteria will receive funds through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The CARES Act enables institutions of higher education to provide emergency grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the pandemic (including food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care).

You are one of the students who will receive a check for \$656.70. We are hopeful that these funds will help you and your family during these most difficult and unsettling times. This emergency grant will NOT affect future financial aid awards from Trinity, and we have been informed that the money will NOT be taxed by the IRS.

To facilitate this process, please make sure we have your current mailing address in our system. Please log on to your Trinity account (TCONLINE) and under "Home address" be sure it has the correct address for you. The college will send a check to this location. We ask that you complete this by May 22. We will then begin processing checks, with the hope of sending checks to you the final week of May.
