Good Afternoon, Jackson residents,

It upsets me to report that, this past weekend, your community was vandalized. This included damage to bathrooms, hallways, and the lounge in the Jackson-Wheaton bridge. Facilities observed:

- lounge chairs broken/damaged
- holes in walls created by thrown chairs
- trash cans knocked over and spilled in hallways
- trash cans emptied onto floors of bathrooms
- paper towel and toilet paper dispensers broken
- broken bottles in bathrooms, shower stalls, and stairwells
- food thrown on hallway floors

Aside from being disrespectful to your peers in Jackson, these incidents represent a safety and hygiene hazard to residents and to the custodial staff who was responsible for cleaning up. In addition to the damage, it's been reported that several residents were being disruptive by yelling in the hallways and banging on doors.

The expectation is that behavior of this sort end immediately. If you have information about what happened, please email me with your observations. **Please note that, in most**

situations in which common areas are vandalized and individuals do not take responsibility, any monetary restitution is divided evenly among all residents of the community.

As a response to these incidents, Dean Goodman, Dean Selders, and I will be leading **amandatory Zoom community meeting for all of Jackson on Thursday, March 18 at 9:00pm** to discuss the behavior and what the Office of the Bantam Network Residential Community and Dean of Students Office expect from the residents of Jackson moving forward.
