Trinity Students,

Per the recent update in our gathering guidance, the Trinity College Greek Life and Social House community will host open socials on Saturday evening, March 12, 2022. All members of the Trinity community are welcome to participate. Additionally, there is an update to our age verification and capacity monitoring operations using wristbands.

Wristbands: Students must pick up wristbands to attend social house events beginning this upcoming weekend. Students must show their Trinity ID to receive a wristband. Students over 21 years will receive a wristband that verifies their age; students under 21 will receive a different wristband. Social houses serving alcohol must abide by our Trinity college alcohol policies. Wristbands can be picked up from Welcome Desk in Mather during their open hours on Friday and Saturday and from the Office of Greek life in the Admissions Building on the bottom floor TODAY until 6 pm and Saturday from 8 pm -11:30 pm. Students MUST bring their Trinity ID to receive a wristband and put their wristband on immediately. Students may not pick up more than one wristband.

Door Policies: Each Social organization is responsible for managing its entrances to its events. Each event must have one designated entrance but several exits to ensure safety with designated sober door managers. In addition, the door managers from each organization will verify that students are wearing their wristbands before they are allowed to enter. Organizations hosting events are held accountable for not exceeding their houses' capacity guidelines or allowing persons without wristbands to enter. All other social gatherings and alcohol policies remain in place, and students should abide by them. We hope our students can enjoy social gatherings this weekend and for the remainder of the semester.
